


On-Resistance vs. Drain Current and Gate Voltage



 $V_{DS}$  - Drain-to-Source Voltage (V) **Capacitance** 





On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature

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






#### Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage





Single Pulse Avalanche Capability



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
