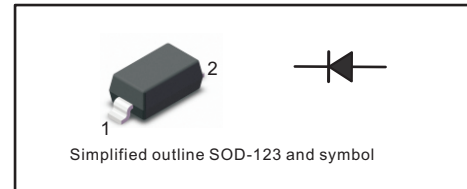

Fig.1 Power Derating Curve

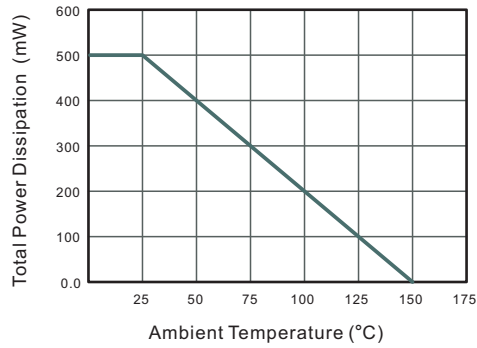


Fig.2 Typical Reverse Characteristics

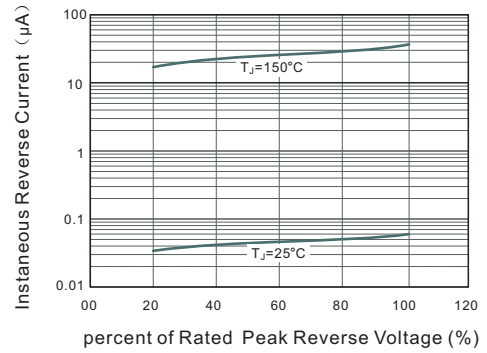


Fig.3 Typical Instantaneous Forward Characteristics

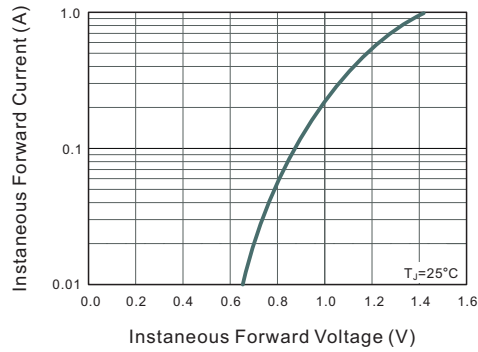
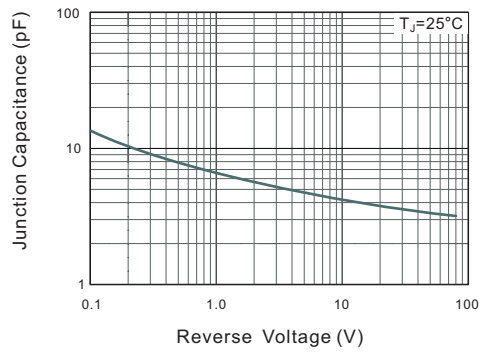


Fig.4 Typical Junction Capacitance

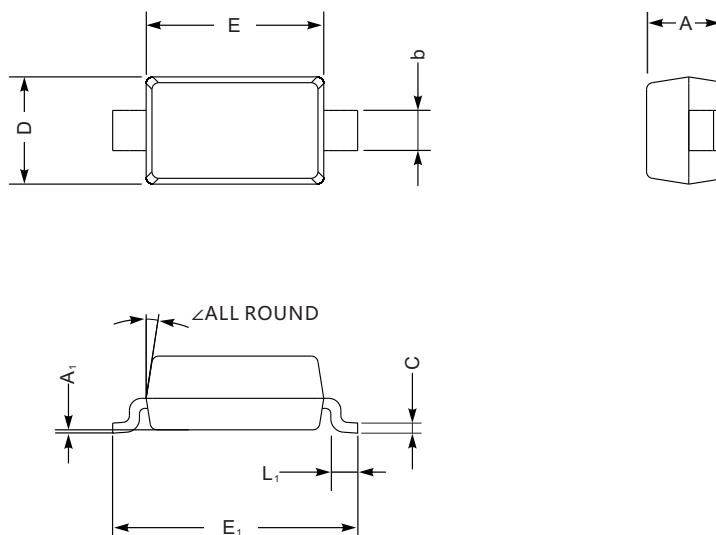

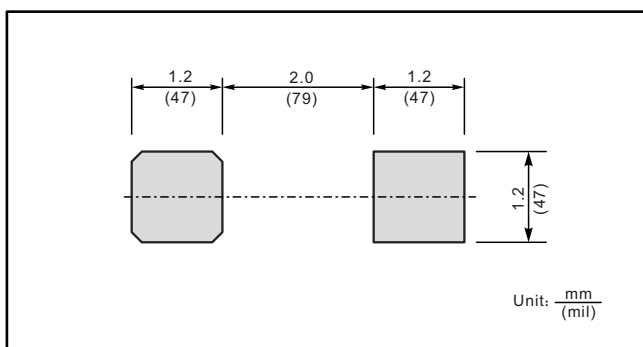
