1. General description

Low capacitance unidirectional ElectroStatic Discharge (ESD) protection diode in an ultra small and flat lead SOD523 (SC-79) Surface-Mounted Device (SMD) plastic packages designed to protect one signal line from the damage caused by ESD and other transients.




Fig. 1. 8/20 µs pulse waveform according to IEC 61000-4-5




Fig. 2. ESD pulse waveform according to IEC 61000-4-2




Fig. 3. Diode capacitance as a function of reverse voltage; typical values






Fig. 4. V-I characteristics for a unidirectional ESD protection diode

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10. Application information

The device is designed for the protection of one unidirectional data or signal line from the damage caused by ESD and surge pulses. The device may be used on lines where the signal polarities are either positive or negative with respect to ground. The device provides a surge capability up to 45 W per line for an $8/20~\mu s$ waveform.



Circuit board layout and protection device placement

Circuit board layout is critical for the suppression of ESD, Electrical Fast Transient (EFT) and surge transients. The following guidelines are recommended:

- 1. Place the device as close to the input terminal or connector as possible.
- 2. Minimize the path length between the device and the protected line.
- 3. Keep parallel signal paths to a minimum.
- 4. Avoid running protected conductors in parallel with unprotected conductors.
- 5. Minimize all Printed-Circuit Board (PCB) conductive loops including power and ground loops.
- 6. Minimize the length of the transient return path to ground.
- 7. Avoid using shared transient return paths to a common ground point.
- 8. Use ground planes whenever possible. For multilayer PCBs, use ground vias.




