Ultra low capacitance unidirectional double ESD protection diode

1. General description

Ultra low capacitance unidirectional double ElectroStatic Discharge (ESD) protection diode in a DFN1006B-3 (SOT883B) leadless ultra small Surface-Mounted Device (SMD) plastic package, designed to protect up to two signal lines from the damage caused by ESD and other transients.

2. Features and benefits

- Ultra low diode capacitance: C_d = 0.50 pF
- Ultra low package height of only 0.37 mm
- ESD protection up to 10 kV; IEC 61000-4-2
- I_{PPM} = 1.5 A; IEC 61000-4-5 (surge)
- Qualified according to AEC-Q101 and recommended for use in automotive applications






Fig. 2. 8/20 µs pulse waveform according to IEC 61000-4-5




Fig. 3. ESD pulse waveform according to IEC 61000-4-2




Fig. 4. Diode capacitance as a function of reverse voltage; typical values






Fig. 5. V-I characteristics for a unidirectional ESD protection diode






10. Application information

The device is designed for the protection of one bidirectional data or signal line from the damage caused by ESD. The device may be used on lines where the signal polarities are both, positive and negative with respect to ground.

The device may also be used for the protection of two unidirectional data or signal lines, which have positive signal polarities with respect to ground.



Circuit board layout and protection device placement

Circuit board layout is critical for the suppression of ESD, Electrical Fast Transient (EFT) and surge transients. The following guidelines are recommended:


- 1. Place the device as close to the input terminal or connector as possible.
- 2. The path length between the device and the protected line should be minimized.
- 3. Keep parallel signal paths to a minimum.
- 4. Avoid running protected conductors in parallel with unprotected conductors.
- 5. Minimize all Printed-Circuit Board (PCB) conductive loops including power and ground loops.
- **6.** Minimize the length of the transient return path to ground.
- 7. Avoid using shared transient return paths to a common ground point.
- 8. Ground planes should be used whenever possible. For multilayer PCBs, use ground vias.


