## TinyLogic UHS Inverter NC7SZ04

#### Description

The NC7SZ04 is a single inverter from **onsemi**'s Ultra–High Speed (UHS) series of TinyLogic. The device is fabricated with advanced CMOS technology to achieve ultra–high speed with high output drive while maintaining low static power dissipation over a broad  $V_{CC}$  operating range. The device is specified to operate over the 1.65 V to 5.5 V  $V_{CC}$  operating range. The inputs and output are high–impedance when  $V_{CC}$  is 0 V. Inputs tolerate voltages up to 5.5 V, independent of  $V_{CC}$  operating voltage.




Figure 1. Logic Symbol




Figure 2. SOT23-5, SC-88A and SC-74A (Top View)




Figure 4. AC Test Circuit





Figure 5. AC Waveforms

Figure 6. I<sub>CCD</sub> Test Circuit

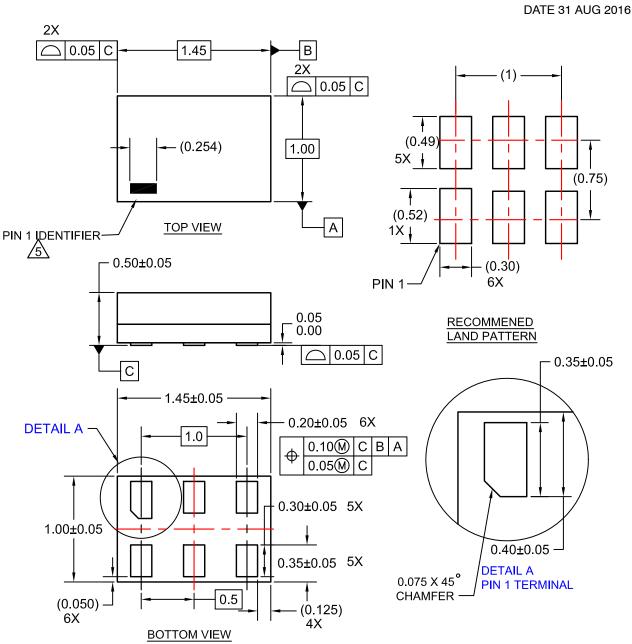

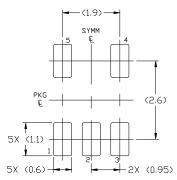
