


On-Resistance vs. Drain Current and Gate Voltage



Capacitance




Gate Charge




On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature







Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage




Threshold Voltage



On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage




Single Pulse Power, Junction-to-Ambient




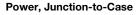
Safe Operating Area, Junction-to-Ambient








Normalized Thermal Transient Impedance, Junction-to-Ambient



Normalized Thermal Transient Impedance, Junction-to-Case (Drain)



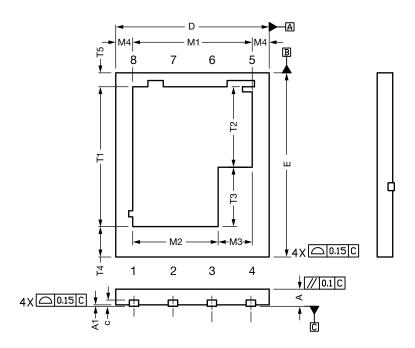
Normalized Thermal Transient Impedance, Junction-to-Case (Source)

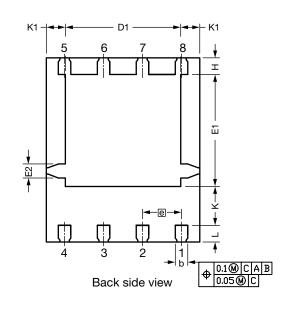

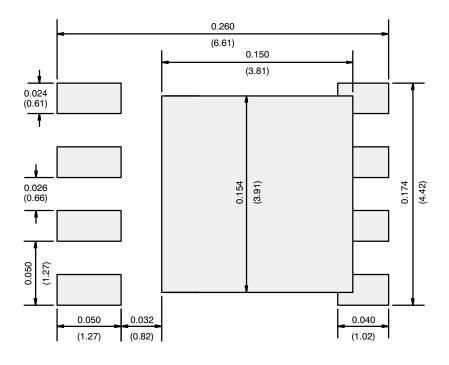
